Days of Service

Fares One-Way

You must pay a fare each time you board the bus. Children from birth to 2 years of age ride free!

Antigo In-City route is a demand response route that runs throughout the city of Antigo. Riders should call to reserve a ride.

Antigo Rural route is a door to door service that serves an 8 mile radius from the center of the city. Map of the service area can be found inside. This service is based on driver and vehicle availability and is a shared ride service.

Langlade Co. route is a door to door service that serves all of Langlade County. This service is based on driver and vehicle availability and is a shared ride service.

Statement of Rider Rights



Rules

- Good manners are required when riding the bus and passengers must not disturb others or the safety of the bus service.
- Wait on the proper side of the roadway for the bus to make a complete stop before approaching the bus.
- Enter the bus with exact fare.
- Please allow elders to use the front seats first.
- Do not change seats after the bus starts moving.
- Baggage and other carry-on items must fit under the rider's seat or be placed on the rider's lap.
- Collapsible baby strollers, band instruments and small coolers are limited to one per person.
- No gasoline, batteries or other flammable or caustic materials are allowed on the bus.
- Menominee Department of Transit Services reserves the right to suspend bus service for passengers who do not follow these rules.
- Absolutely no smoking in or around any Menominee Department of Transit Services vehicles.
- Riders may utilize personal radios, cassette players, CD players, DVD/Movie players with headphones, as to not impede on drivers ability to safely hear traffic and two-way radio communications.

Langlade County Public Transit buses are accessible to persons with disabilities and mobility devices such as wheel-chairs, electric scooters, walkers and crutches. Drivers are trained to assist disabled passengers boarding and exiting the vehicles. Please let your driver know of any special conditions. Aides and service animals are allowed to ride with you. Your service animal must stay on the floor by you or on your lap.

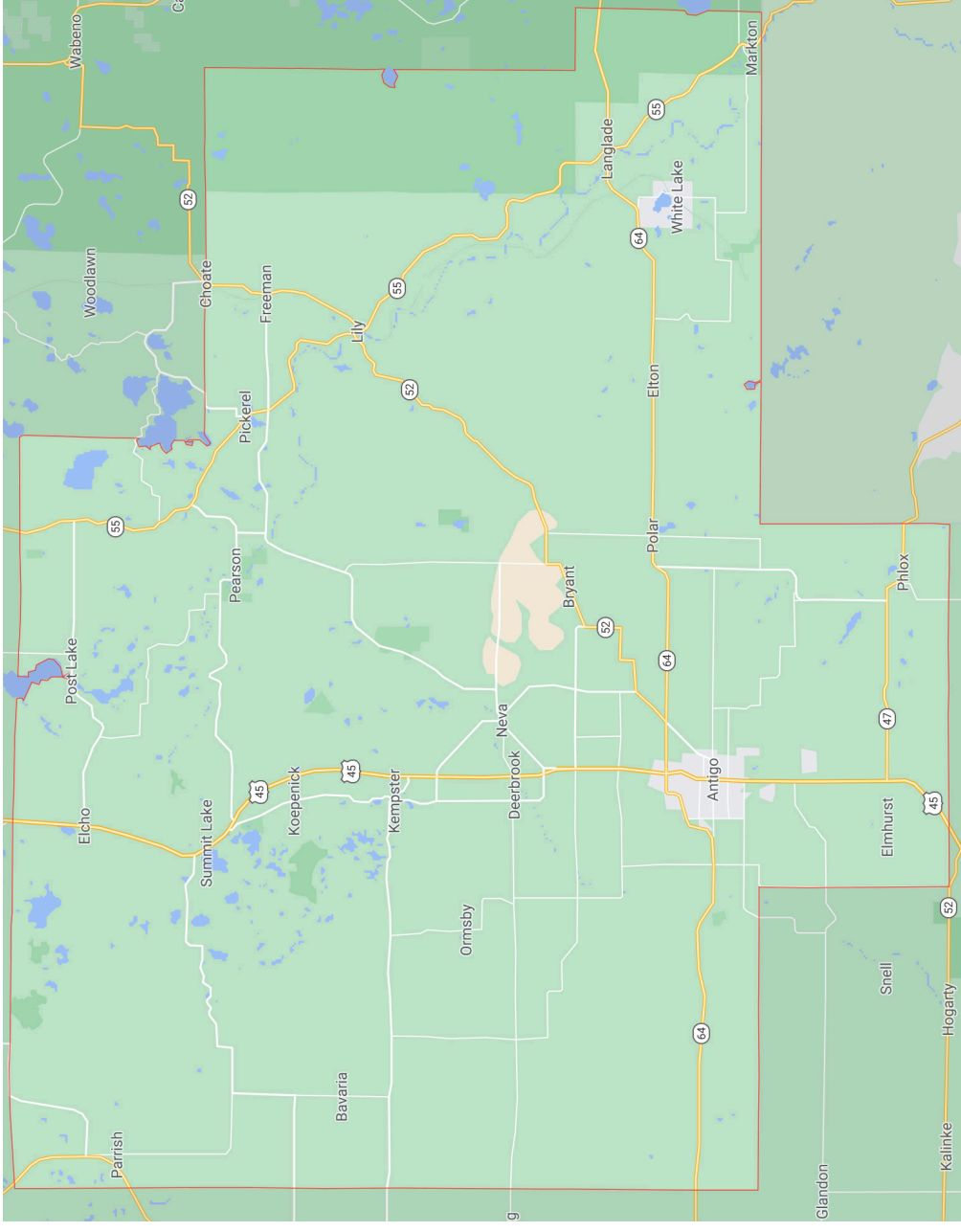

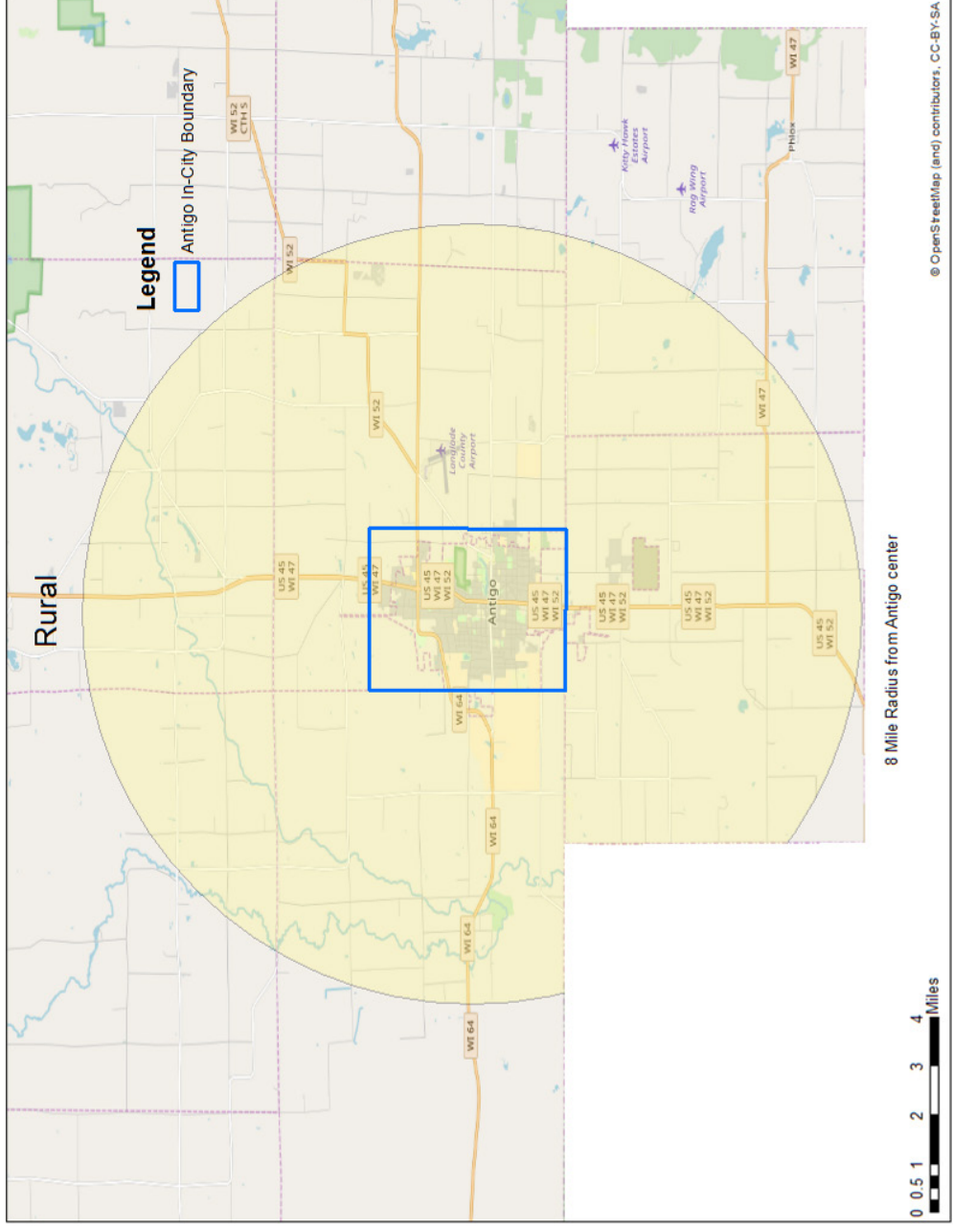

Langlade County Map



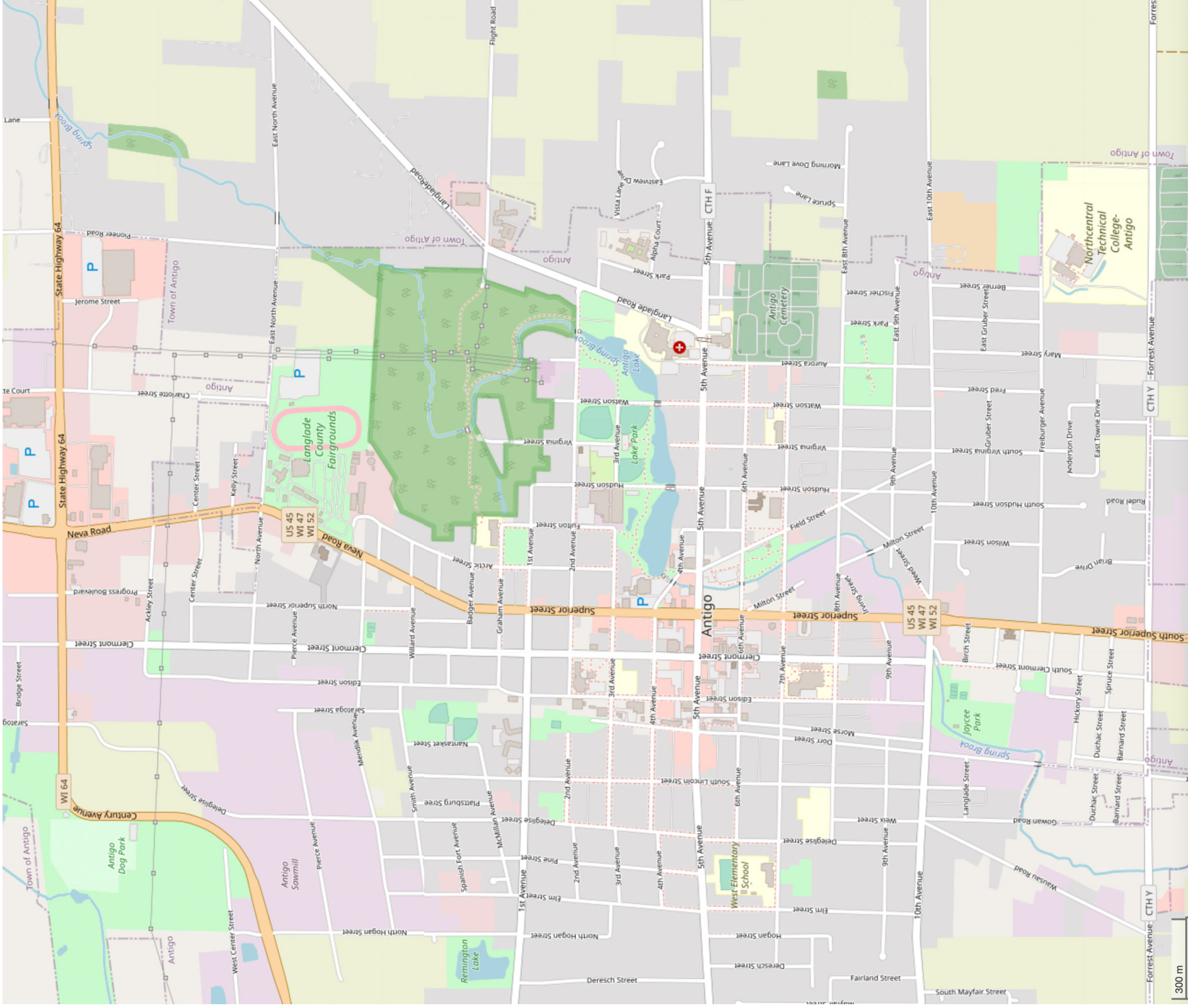
Rural Map
