

## KESHENA AND NEOPIT ADA PARATRANSIT FOR FIXED ROUTES

Paratransit service is required by the federal Americans with Disabilities Act and is provided for customers whose disability or health condition prevents them from using Menominee Regional Public Transit fixed route services for some or all of their travel. Only persons who are certified and carry a Paratransit ID card are eligible to ride ADA Paratransit. Trips are provided at the same times and within the same geographic areas as the fixed route. To become certified you must apply at the Menominee Regional Public Transit Center in Keshena, Wisconsin. The rider must have their paratransit ID card with them at all times when using the service. This is a shared ride door-to-door/curbside service.



### HOW TO USE ADA PARATRANSIT SERVICE

To use the paratransit service, call 1-877-MITWBUS with the address you will be picked up and the address you will be dropped off and the time you need to be at your destination.



## DISABLED RIDERS

Menominee Transit buses are accessible to persons with disabilities and mobility devices such as wheelchairs, electric scooters, walkers and crutches. Drivers are trained to assist disabled passengers boarding and exiting the vehicles. Please let your driver know of any special conditions. Aides and service animals are allowed to ride with you. Your service animal must stay on the floor by you or on your lap.



### STATEMENT OF RIDER RIGHTS

In accordance with the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Menominee Regional Public Transit does not discriminate on the basis of disability, race, color, national origin or gender. ## RULES

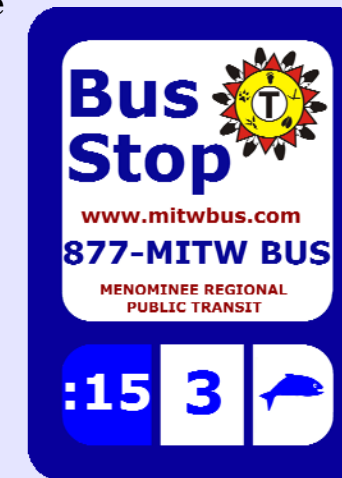
- Good manners are required when riding the bus and passengers must not disturb others or the safety of the bus service.
- Wait on the proper side of the roadway for the bus to make a complete stop before approaching the bus.
- Enter the bus with exact fare.
- Please let Senior Citizens the use of front seats first.
- When standing please move to the rear of the bus and always hold onto standee hand bars or wear seatbelts.
- Do not change seats after the bus starts moving.
- Baggage and other carry-on items must fit under the rider's seat or be placed on the rider's lap.
- Collapsible baby strollers, band instruments and small coolers are limited to one per person.
- No gasoline, batteries or other flammable or caustic materials are allowed on the bus.
- Menominee Regional Public Transit reserves the right to suspend bus service for passengers who do not follow these rules.

## HOW TO RIDE THE BUS: 6 EASY STEPS

- 1 Call for information or go to [www.mitwbus.com](http://www.mitwbus.com)**
  - Learn which bus to take.
  - Learn when and where to catch the bus.
  - Learn the exact fare needed.
  - Learn when you will arrive at your destination.
  - Compliments and complaints.
- 2 If you are using a time table**
  - Make sure you have the current time table. Look for the route number, color, symbol or the destination served by the route.
  - Read across the top of the time table to find the stop names for where you want to get on and off the bus.
  - Read down the column under where you want to get off the bus until you find the time you want to arrive. Next, move left back across the time row and find the time shown in the column under where you want to get on the bus. This is the time when you need to be at the bus stop to start your trip. Be at your stop a few minutes early.

### 3 Finding your stop or flag stops

- Study the route map and look for a stop closest to where you are. Buses stop at all stops with our signs.



- If you can't get to a stop the bus will pick up passengers at flag stops. This means the bus will stop at most corners if it is safe to do so. Signal the driver by waving when the bus is a half-block away to let the driver know you want to be picked up.



There are no flag stops on Hwy 29, Hwy 41, Hwy 172 or Interstate 43.

You must be standing safely at the edge of the road. Runners are discouraged and can not be served.

### 4 Knowing which bus is yours

- You can tell where the bus is going by the sign on the front of the bus above the windshield. The sign tells what the final destination is. If you are not sure it is the right bus, ask the driver.



### 5 Paying your fare

- Passes are available from the Transit Center at W2727 Our Childrens Road, Keshena, Wisconsin.
- Pay on the bus with cash, tickets or a bus pass.

### 6 Getting off the bus

- About a block before your stop, let the bus driver know that you want to get off the bus. If you are not sure where your stop is, ask the bus driver.
- When you get off the bus be sure you have all of your belongings.
- For your safety, step away from the bus and wait until the bus pulls away before crossing the street so you can see traffic clearly.

## ELDERLY/SHOPPING SERVICE

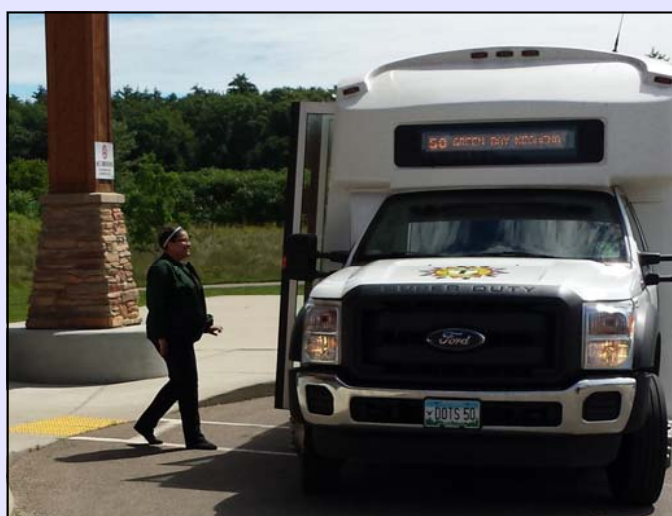
Services are available for shopping, going to and from stores in the area. Seniors and others can enjoy the comfort and ease of shopping with this service.

Demand Response is a shared ride door-to-door/curbside service at a premium price. It is a first come-first served service based on driver and vehicle availability. Call to reserve a seat.

## PASSES/TICKETS

## GREEN BAY AND SHAWANO FLEX SERVICE

These routes offer flex service. If you can not make it to one of the stops or flag the bus, you must call and ask for flex service. The bus will deviate up to 2 blocks from the regular route. Flex service is offered at an additional cost.

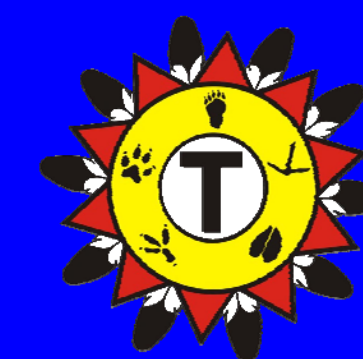
